The Ken McDonald Women's Golf Association (KMWGA) was established in 1976 and plays Tuesday mornings with our regular season running November through May. We have just over 100 members with 55-65 ladies playing weekly. The league provides friendly fun competitions each week.

New membership and renewals are completed online starting Oct. 1st. The KMWGA dues cover the KMWGA season, and the AGA fee covers Oct. 1 thru the following Dec. We also offer seasonal memberships, if you join after January 1st, the KMWGA dues cover the KMWGA season, and the AGA fee covers the calendar year. If you are a member of more than one club, the AGA fee is reduced for the additional clubs you join.

KMWGA membership dues include entry into each Play of the Day to cover prize money. Should you choose to play in quarterly special events and tournaments, minimal entry fees are required.

KMWGA by-laws require a new member to have a handicap or to turn in a minimum of 3 score cards totaling 54 holes (from any course) at time of signup.

We realize the Ken McDonald Golf Course can be difficult primarily due to its length. The league does NOT have a handicap cap, we just want you to feel comfortable with the length of the course, the basic rules of golf, and playing at an appropriate pace-of-play.
